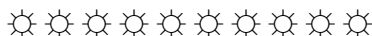

## **THE MIDLANDS COUNTIES SHOW IS A QUALIFIER FOR:**

**COMPETITORS MUST MAKE THEMSELVES AWARE OF ANY RULES REGARDING ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE, AS LAID DOWN BY THE SOCIETY TO WHICH THEIR CLASSES ARE AFFILIATED.**

**BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS:** This is a qualifying show for the British Arabian Championships to be held at Kings Equestrian Centre [www.kingsequestrian.co.uk](http://www.kingsequestrian.co.uk) on the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Qualification for the BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS is via Gold Card, which are awarded to 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Arab Horse Society Affiliated Classes. Completed Gold Cards should be returned within 10 days of the qualifying show with a cheque for £15 or Return the Card before 18<sup>th</sup> August with a cheque for £30. Cheques should be made payable to **The Arab Horse Society**. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes, 120 - 122 - 127 - 129, 140 - 143, 146 - 148 & 152- 153, the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> from classes 119, 124, 126 & 137 - 139 and the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> in mixed Height classes will qualify for the BSPS Championship Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rule 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member, all persons entering, competing or otherwise taking part whether a Member or not shall be deemed to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

Qualification for Horse of the Year Show will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office.

**BSPS 'CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP' CHALLENGE 2021:** All BSPS affiliated shows are qualifiers for the BSPS Classic Services Group' Challenge. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competing in the appropriate class:- Open L/R, F/R, Open Show Pony, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Ponies, L/R of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Ponies, Open Intermediate SRT, SHT and WH, Open Heritage LR & F/R Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden and WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2021 Horse of the year Show. If a pony qualifies for the Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit its qualification for 'The B.S.P.S Challenge'.

**BSPS BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR:** The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed ponies will qualify in the following classes:- Open L/R, F/R, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony and the Open Intermediate SRT, SHT and WH.

### **THE B.S.P.S. BINKS FAMILY' CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS:-**

The 1<sup>st</sup> Prize winners in the following classes Will Qualify - Open L/R, F/R, Open Show Pony, Open L/RHT Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony and the Open Intermediate SRT, SHT and WH and Open Heritage L/R, F/R, Ridden and WHP.

### **THE B.S.P.S. "THE WHITE COMPANY" MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS:-**

The 1<sup>st</sup> Prize winners in the following classes Will Qualify – Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes.

**BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION:** - Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members (**Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form**). Riders must be 15 years of age or older. In **RIHS Qualifying Classes:** 111 – 117, the first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. **Horse of the Year Show Qualifying Classes: 7, 12, 14 – 17.** In class **7** the first prize winner will qualify, if already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. In **Classes 12, 14 -17 the qualification will pass down to 5<sup>th</sup> place, the qualification will not pass below 5<sup>th</sup> place.** Horses competing at the RIHS & the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in the Hunter sections of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The 1<sup>st</sup> or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the **BSHA Classic of the Year Final.** The Finals will be held at the BSH Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2021. The BSHA offer a Novice, Amateur and Young Rider Rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and the Horse of the year Show Hunter Classes). The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year. **Day Tickets** – Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse per Rider per season. At Midland Counties Show a Day Ticket will allow entry into the Open Working Show Horse, Amateur and Novice classes only, but will not allow entry into RIHS & Horse of the Year Show qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form or apply on line on the BSHA website. **NEW CLASSES FOR 2021:** Classes 101-102 will be **OPEN to MEMBERS & NON MEMBERS of the BSHA**

**BSHA –SEIB Working Show Horse:** Held under the rules of the BSHA, class 10 is a qualifier for the SEIB Working Show Horse of the Year to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. The two highest placed horses in the top five, not already qualified will Qualify for the final. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members, or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket, Riders 15 years old and over.

**[For full rules and eligibility see BSHA rule book].** [Fences: min. 2'9, max. 3'0, spread 3'0]

**(BSHA) – Polly Coles Supreme Qualifier -In Hand – Horses, Owners and Handlers** must be current members of the Association or have Temporary Membership with a Day Ticket. The BSHA offer an Owner/Breeder rosette in each In Hand Breeding class with the exception of the Foal class, these have been kindly sponsored by the Kellythorpe Stud.

## **BSHA Classes Continued**

Classes 64 – 66 & 78– 80 are Qualifiers for the NPS/ Ottergale Hack & Riding Horse In Hand Supreme Championship the final to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show. **To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021.**

**COLOURED HORSE AND PONY SOCIETY (UK):** This show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) Show Affiliation No. 21049

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card in THE RING for signing by the Judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card. **The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> August 2021.** Shows held on or after the 9<sup>th</sup> August will count as 2021 qualifiers. All Stallions 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS (UK) in order to c4 – **167 & 101– 104 are CHAPS (UK) qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members Handbook; or visit: [www.chapsuk.com](http://www.chapsuk.com).** for rulings;

**HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW 2021 Qualifiers [Classes 162 – 165]:** These classes are qualifying classes for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, October 2021. Qualification will not pass below 5<sup>th</sup> place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show Office. This competition is open to mares, gelding and CHAPS (UK) graded stallions, four years old or over, to be registered in and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of the stud books of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society CHAPS (UK) or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA). **All Stallions MUST wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception in order to compete.** All Riders and Owners must be members of the Coloured Horse and Pony Society, The Showing Register or the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association.

For height restricted exhibits a valid JMB number must be lodged with the respective society. **These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show Rule book, a copy of which can be downloaded from [www.hoys.co.uk](http://www.hoys.co.uk) and competitors must make themselves conversant with these rules before entering these classes.**

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit: [www.grandstandentries.com](http://www.grandstandentries.com).

**Marks will be awarded in the following way: Ride/Performance – 50 Marks Maximum: Conformation, Movement & Quality – 50 Marks Maximum.** In the event of equality the horse with the highest Ride/Performance mark will be deemed the winner, if there is still equality at this point, then the Judges' decision will be final

**NCPA PONY OF THE YEAR:-** The 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify for NCPA Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby in September 2021

**UK PONIES & HORSES LTD: Affiliation 21/A18/8147** For full rules and eligibility see Rule Book 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horses/ponies will qualify for the 2021 (UK) Ponies & Horses Ltd Summer Classic and BSPA 2021

**SPORT HORSE BREEDING of GREAT BRITAIN:** To be judged under SHB(GB) Rules. Competitors must be conversant with these rules before entering affiliated classes. SHB(GB) require all exhibits in these Classes to be registered with them.

**DAY TICKET = £36.** (This entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year – it covers owner Membership together with horse registration for that show). See current SHB(GB) handbook or the rules and regulations published on the SHB(GB) website for other relevant information

## **THE NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY:**

**NPS M & M QUALIFYING ROUNDS:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS Competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and **NON-MEMBERS, BUT ONLY** ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021. **The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify For the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's membership card to be shown in the ring**

**NPS/SHOW PONY & SHOW HUNTER PONY QUALIFYING ROUNDS:** To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register: The GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony Studbook sections or The Ridden Register. Ponies must be plaited. **Classes are open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years old and over.**

Qualifying open to ponies owned by NPS members and **NON-MEMBERS, BUT ONLY** ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021. **The highest placed pony owned by an NPS Member, in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification may pass down to third place in the line, Owner's Membership card to be shown in the ring.**

### **NPS Classes Continued**

**NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS:** To be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life Member** of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion pony provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS and has the required membership card in their possession. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

**NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship:** Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in the classes where this is indicated. These ponies if owned by NPS members, are then Eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

**This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders in Hand Supreme Championship, Sponsored by "M P GLOSS PRODUCTS UK LTD". The Champion and Reserve from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland In Hand will qualify for the final to be held at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS**

### **SHETLAND PONY STUD- BOOK SOCIETY:**

1) Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies **must be named on the entry form** and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.

2) Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show. *Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. In-hand stallions 2 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle badge.*

3) There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-Hand classes. Children under 12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-Hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard Hats must be worn by all exhibitors irrespective of age in ridden classes. *Ridden and driven ponies must be 4years old and over.* In ridden Classes if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

### **THE TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB ASSOCIATION (TGCA): In Hand & Ridden classes**

**No known breeding required to enter these classes. No Membership required to enter these classes.**

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Traditional classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Traditional finals at 'TOYS'

Part Bred classes open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at 'TOYS'. The exhibit must have One parent that is a traditional gypsy cob.

**Stallions;-** All stallions (**4years and over**) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class **MUST** be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain as per current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members **MUST** receive a qualification card from the Judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.
