Winner of the Quest of Mendick Salver for the highest-placed Highland, owned by a Member of the Society at HOYS was Moss-side McLaren owned by Rose Macpherson.

Winner of the Rannoch of Trailtrow Quaich for the highest-placed Highland owned by a Member of the Society at Olympia was Moss-side Iain Mor, owned by Jean Ralston.

Winner of the Sue Giles Memorial Quaich for the Junior with the highest number of points in the Scottish and English Performance Schemes again goes to Alexy Jackson riding Stourton Jethro. She scored 1745 points. Runner-up from Scotland was Devon Sloan, riding Fingal of Strathavon. She scored 1235 points.

A Special Achievement Award was presented to Bob Davidson, the Owner/Breeder of the In-Hand and Ridden Champions at the Royal Highland Show, both by the same sire. His stallion, Ruaridh of Mendick was sire of the Breed Show In-Hand and both Novice & Open Ridden Champions; he won the Blair Ridden Championship and the NPS In-Hand Silver Medal
