Virtual Stallion Parade 2022

~ A new initiative from the Highland Pony Society ~

GENERAL INFORMATION

The aim of the 'Virtual Stallion Parade' is to assist breeders in promoting their stallions, both those standing at stud and those not, and to showcase and celebrate the Highland Pony breed to a wider audience around the UK and beyond. The parade will be broadcast at the beginning of April and will be accessible indefinitely following its first airing.

The parade is open to fully licenced and registered Highland pony stallions owned by current members of the Highland Pony Society.

ENTRIES

The parade is free to enter for current HPS members. To enter, fill in the entry form at the back of this schedule and return via email to cwgrant@outlook.com by 2359hrs on 31 January 2022. Content for the parade is to be included within this email or follow at a time when requested. After this time, entries to the parade cannot be received. We encourage entries and content to be sent well in advance of this date to assist with administration. The Society encourages all stallion owners to take part in the parade. Submissions will be accepted from all licensed stallions both standing at stud and those not standing at stud.

REQUIREMENTS

The content submitted from stallion owners is not limited and the content submitted for videos is left entirely to your imagination. Submissions should enhance the stallion's entry and highlight the stallion's merits to a higher level.

Alongside the completed entry form, a minimum of four photos should be sent to give basic entry to the parade. These should include; a headshot, full side view, front view and a moving shot.

As this is a virtual parade it is strongly encouraged that videos are sent showing the stallion walking away and trotting back. Other suggestions of videos and photos for inclusion are:

- At leisure in the field
- In action in the field
- In action at a show or competition
- Displaying prizes at a show or competition
- In action during a training session

Videos should be sent in short format and the society will correlate them together to make each stallions individual entry to the parade. An example of the work we hope to prepare can be watched at the following link: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OFM5MIIgeWQ>

VIRTUAL PARADE RULES

1. On entering any of the classes within the Highland Pony Society Virtual Parade you accept and abide by the Rules and Terms & Conditions laid out here.
2. Entries to the parade are open to current HPS members only.
3. Only registered and licenced Highland pony stallions in the HPS Full Register can take part.
4. At the time of entry, the exhibitor must be recorded by the HPS as the registered owner or loanee of the pony. Height must not exceed 14.2hh (148cms).
5. No entry will be accepted without the fully completed entry form.
6. No substitutions allowed.
7. The Highland Pony Society reserves the right to refuse an entry without stating a reason.
8. The closing date for entries to the competition is 31 January 2022.
9. By submitting a photo to this show, you are deemed to have agreed that the Highland Pony Society may reproduce the photograph on the HPS social media pages and website.
10. You are entering at your own risk. The Highland Pony Society takes no responsibility for any injury occurred to either horse or rider/handler whilst photographing or videoing their entry.
11. Correct attire and appropriate protective wear **MUST** be worn.
12. Copyright laws must be adhered to when submitting photographs or printed material. The Highland Pony Society will not be liable for any costs incurred as a result of infringement of copyright laws by any entrant.
