

## IN HAND AWARD SCHEME RULES

- 1 The Awards are a competitive scheme aimed at encouraging showing of Highland ponies of all ages. The awards run for one year from 1 January to 31 December.
- 2 There will be one UK wide scheme; results will be announced online, with presentations made at the Performance Awards Ceremony.
- 3 Ponies must belong to paid up members of the Society.
- 4 Passports must be up to date and reflect the correct registered owner of the pony.
- 5 The handler need not be a member of the Society.
- 6 One card per handler/pony combination.
- 7 The scheme is open to licensed stallions, mares, geldings, colts and fillies fully registered or in Appendices.
- 8 Points are also awarded for participation.
- 9 Record the number of ponies in the class.
- 10 Record placings in the placing box, using a separate line for each class and each championship. Do not record any event more than once. Please do not write in the shaded area. The Secretary uses this area to record your points.
- 11 Points may be collected at shows and properly organised events. Schedules may have to be submitted to the committee if required.
- 12 Cards may be obtained from the HPS Website / Office. There is no charge for cards once again in 2026. Cards may be downloaded from the HPS Website or by sending a Large letter SAE to the office.
- 13 If members wish to participate in both the Performance and In Hand Schemes a card for each is required.
- 14 If an owner wishes to participate in the Scheme with more than one pony, the second and subsequent books should be requested.
- 15 All competitors who return their cards will receive a rosette. Special Rosettes will also be awarded to the Highest Placed Foal, Yearling, 2yrs, 3yrs and the best Stallion, Mare and Gelding four years and over, Colt, Filly and Junior Gelding and to the highest placed veteran (15yrs & over). The breeder of the overall winner will also receive a special rosette.
- 16 Within this scheme, Junior exhibitors will be given additional rosettes and the highest placed will receive a trophy. Please note that Junior Handler classes are not applicable (see note under points). A Junior exhibitor must be aged between 12 and 18yrs on 1<sup>st</sup> January.
